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**In making this request, the undersigned agrees to accept the following conditions and requirements:**

- I/We will work with the Upstate Heritage Quilt Trail Committee regarding design and colors of the proposed quilt panel.
- The block cannot be a company logo.
- The barn or building site must be accessible for installation.
- The Quilt panel will remain on the building at least five years. After that time, the Quilt panel will remain on the building until the owner asks for it to be removed, relocated or it becomes apparent that the piece needs to be repaired. Should the owner relocate the panel to another location the UHQT needs to be notified to update its reference materials.
- Once the block is signed off on, no changes may be made to the quilt panel. I will not move or alter the quilt panel in any way without first contacting the Upstate Heritage Quilt Trail Committee.
- If I rent, lease, sell or otherwise convey my property during this time, I will notify the Upstate Heritage Quilt Trail Committee to allow them to remove the quilt block, if necessary, to avoid damage to it.
- I will allow my barn/building to be photographed by the public and photos to be used by the Upstate Heritage Quilt Trail Committee in advertising of the quilt trail. I will allow my name and/or my business's name to be used on advertising and promotional materials.
- I understand people will be taking pictures of my block.
- Repairs due to vandalism or natural causes is the responsibility of the quilt panel owner. Please notify the Upstate Heritage Quilt Trail, to assist with repairs.

Each block we put up is linked in some way (usually by the name of the block) to the history of the site, the family hosting the block or the county. Use the space below to write out brief highlights of your story, such as history of the land, the buildings, or your family. The quilt block chosen for your site could come from a quilt made by someone in your family. Everyone has a story, and your story doesn't have to be elaborate. If you know who built the barns or other structures on your land, list them. If you know of any interesting things that have happened on your land, list them. If you know that your grandmother made quilts and your grandfather was a blacksmith, list that. If you wish to honor someone in your family with the block, tell us that. If you are an artist, gardener, financier tell us that. Later someone will be assigned to interview you and get the complete story and it will then be written. We will use the information you list on the back of this form to find appropriate blocks for you to choose from. We prefer that the blocks have the appearance of traditional quilt blocks, i.e. designed on a grid, and that it is possible to actually make them from fabric. We are trying to avoid duplicating blocks so if you have a preference let us know right away. You can attach your story if the space below isn't large enough.
