Each block we put up is linked in some way (usually by the name of the block) to the history of the site, the family hosting the block or the county. Use the space below to write out brief highlights of your story, such as history of the land, the buildings, or your family. The quilt block chosen for your site could come from a quilt made by someone in your family. Everyone has a story, and your story doesn't have to be elaborate. If you know who built the barns or other structures on your land, list them. If you know of any interesting things that have happened on your land, list them. If you know that your grandmother made quilts and your grandfather was a blacksmith, list that. If you wish to honor someone in your family with the block, tell us that. If you are an artist, gardener, financier tell us that. Later someone will be assigned to interview you and get the complete story and it will then be written. We will use the information you list on the back of this form to find appropriate blocks for you to choose from. We prefer that the blocks have the appearance of traditional quilt blocks, i.e. designed on a grid, and that it is possible to actually make them from fabric. We are trying to avoid duplicating blocks so if you have a preference let us know right away. You can attach your story if the space below isn't large enough.
